

Sequencing: How to Make a Peanut Butter and Jelly Sandwich

Sue loves peanut butter and grape jelly sandwiches. Can you make one for her? She doesn't like chunky peanut butter or raspberry jam, because the bits of peanuts and the seeds from the jam, get stuck in her teeth. Cut out the pieces of bread and put them in order of how you would make the sandwich.

Hint: Not all pieces of bread will be used.

Take out the jar of grape jelly.

Close the sandwich by putting the peanut butter and jelly together.

Take out the jar of smooth peanut butter.

Take out the jar of raspberry jam with seeds.

Take out the jar of chunky peanut butter.

Using a knife, spread peanut butter on one slice of bread.

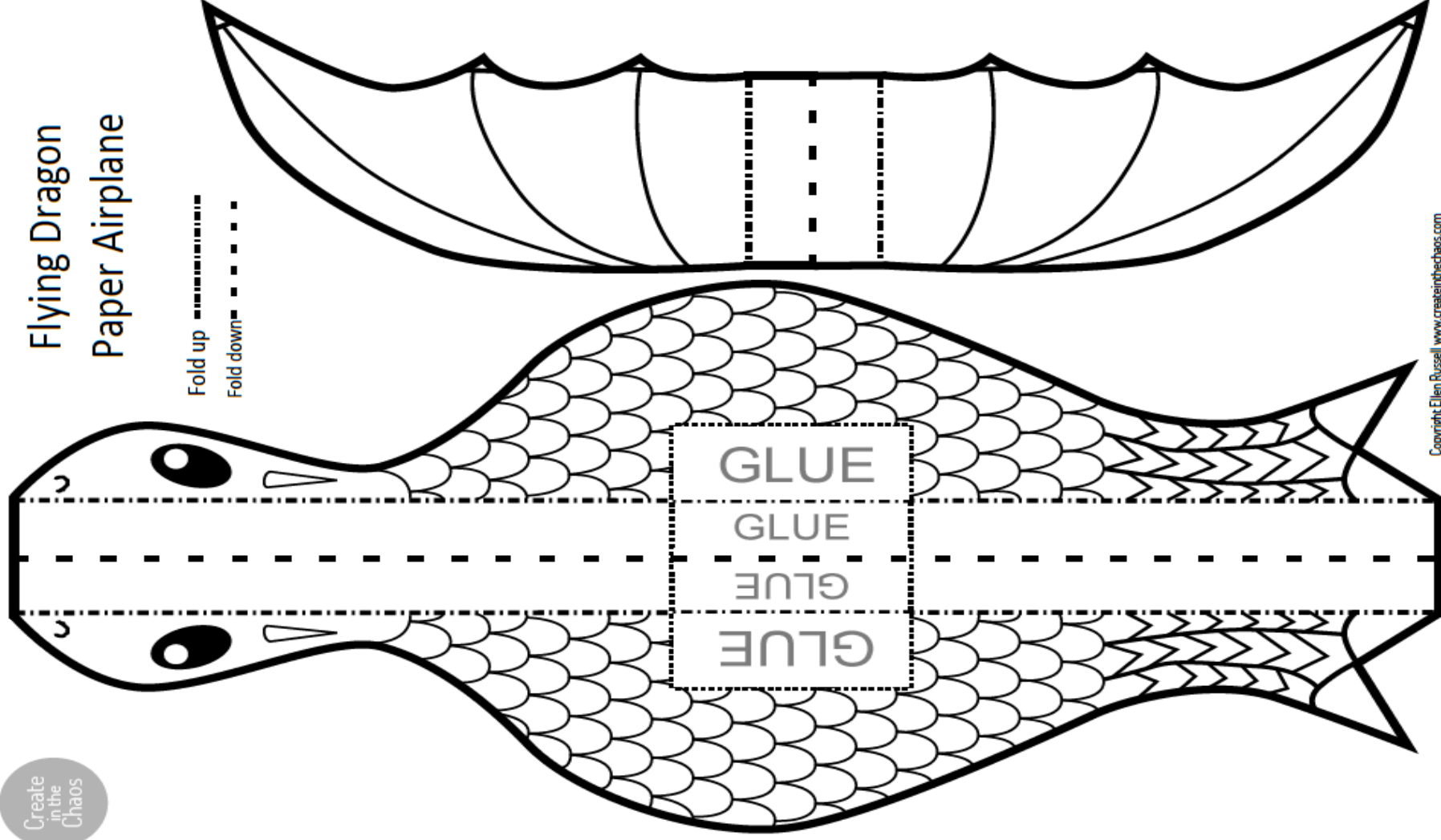
Using a knife, spread raspberry jam on a slice of bread.

Take out 2 slices of bread and put them on a plate.

Using a knife, spread the grape jelly on the other slice of bread.

Colored pencils,

Cut out dragon body
and wings.

Fold along dotted
lines, either up or
down according to
key. (Hint: your
colored side will be
the top.)

Glue wings onto
body where shown.

Put paper clip on
nose of dragon. You
need the paper clip
to balance the
dragon for flight.
