

PAPER ROCKET

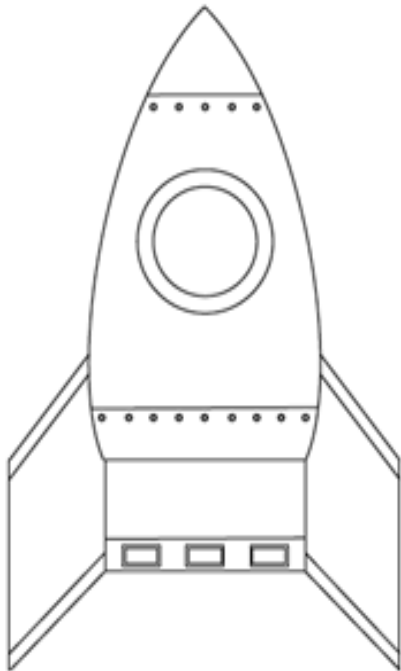
What you need: Markers/crayons/colored pencils, scissors, tape or glue stick, drinking straw.

1. Color rockets any way you want.
2. Cut rockets out.
3. With your colored side down:

If using glue stick: Put glue on outer edge of rocket. DO NOT GLUE THE FINS. Fold fins out. Be sure to leave enough room to insert a straw into the rocket.

If using tape: Tape outer edge of rocket, making sure to seal the nose. Fold fins out and use a small piece of tape across the fins to seal together.

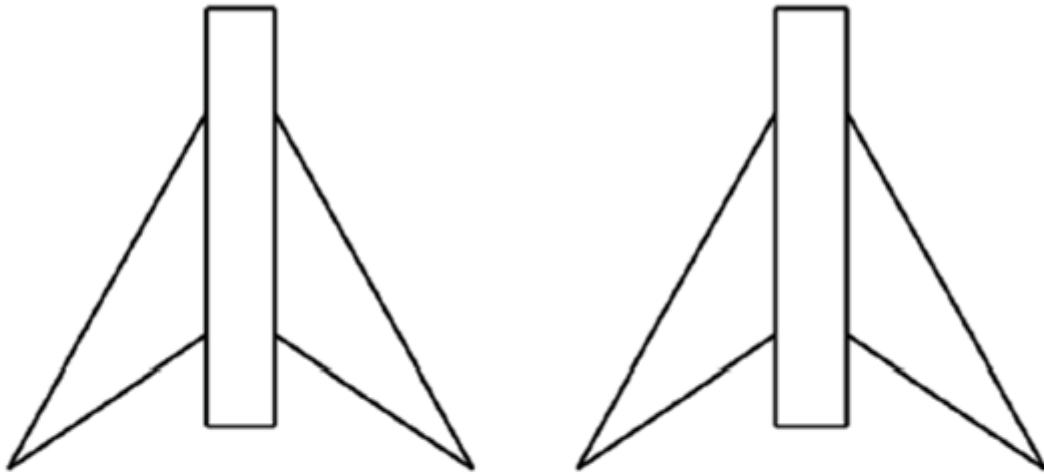
4. Insert straw and blow!



ROLLED PAPER ROCKET

Materials needed: Markers/crayons/colored pencil, tape, straw.

1. Color rectangle and fins any way you want.
2. Cut out rectangle and fins.
3. Place pencil on one end of rectangle and roll around pencil. Tape along the entire edge.

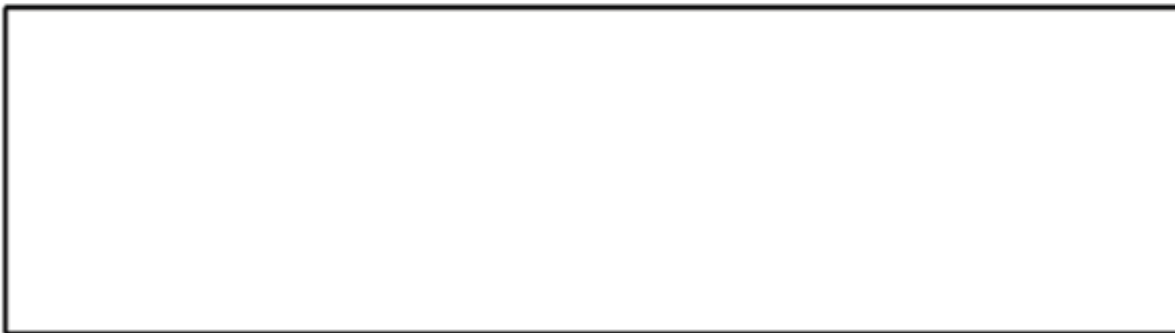

4. Squeeze top of rolled paper together or fold over to create the “nose” of the rocket. Make sure nose is sealed completely.

5. Tape fins to bottom of rocket.

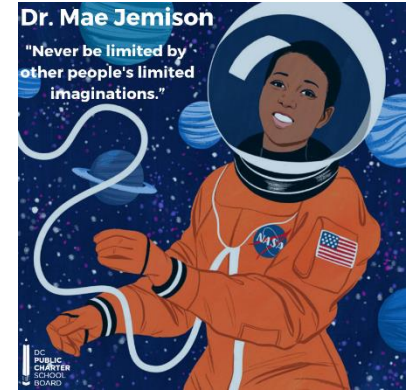
6. Remove pencil. Insert straw into paper tube and launch your rocket by blowing into straw.
