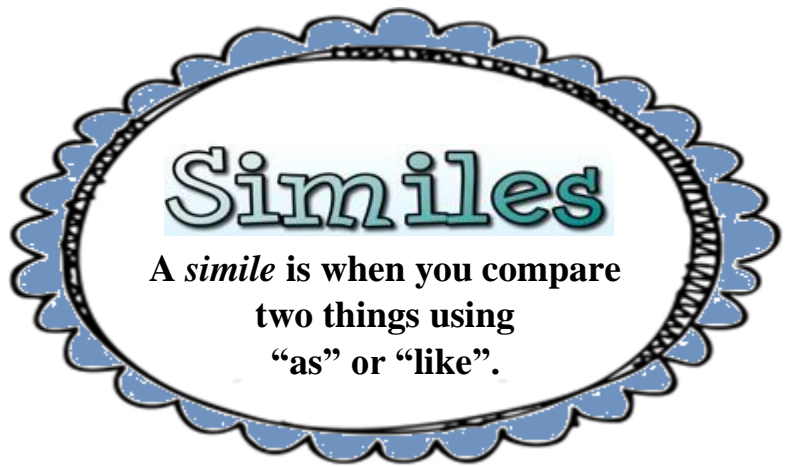

**"As" similes: as + adjective + as + noun**
