Prevention Tips & Identifying Symptoms



What are the symptoms?

Symptoms can appear between 2-14 days after exposure they can include:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath,
- Difficulty breathing

How does COVID-19 spread?

When respiratory droplets produced when an infectious person coughs or sneezes they touch an object or surface with the virus on it. You then touch that surface and then touch your mouth, nose or eyes. Or It spreads when you have close contact with an infectious person.
