



Tongue Twisting Alliteration Activity

Alliteration: the repetition of the same sound at the beginning of multiple words in a sentence

Tongue Twister: a phrase that is difficult to say because of the use of **alliteration**

Follow the instructions to create a tongue twister:

1. Pick a letter
2. Write down a bunch of words that begin with that letter or letter sound.
3. Create a sentence using as many of those words as you can in the box below.

Ex.

Letter	Words
G	jump giraffe juggle Jake jellybeans jingle joy jello jolly jelly jungle Gerald jack-o-lantern jiggle gigantic
Gigantic Gerald giraffe jumped and jiggled joyously, while juggling jack-o-lanterns and jellybeans.
